ABSTRACT: The clinical study on WRULD of 30 cases was undertaken to explore the miasmatic background [Psora, Sycosis, Syphilis and combinations thereof] based on predisposition, to find the efficacy of homoeopathy in WRULD. Out of 30 cases, 4 cases recovered (13.33%); 17 cases improved (56.6%); and 9 cases did not improve (30%). The remedies prescribed were Lach -4 cases [13.3%], Lyco -3 cases (10%), Sulph, Calc phos, caust, Phos, Acid phos, Chel -2 cases each (6.66%); Sil,Cimic,Ars,Ruta,Rhus T,Amm C,Puls,Kali B, Nat M,Rhodo,Viola 0 in 1 case each (3.33%). Intercurrents -Medorrh, Syph, Tuberc, and Thuja. WRULD, is an occupational disease and most of the times it is not possible to remove the maintaining cause. So by addressing the predisposition and miasm, homoeopathy offers better treatment for these patients.
