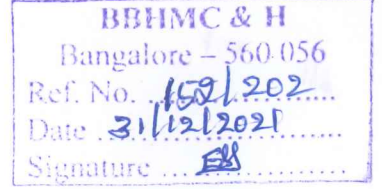

Sir,

As Central Government by notification, constituted a Commission, to be known as the National Commission for Homoeopathy, to exercise the powers conferred upon, and to perform the functions assigned to it, under NCH Act 2020. As per section 59 (2) of NCH Act, 2020, following has been stated:

“Notwithstanding the repeal of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act 1973, the educational and medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder: Provided that anything done or any action taken as regards the educational and medical standards and requirements under the enactment under repeal and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provision of this Act and shall continue in force accordingly unless and until superseded by anything or by any action taken under this Act”.

1. As per provision in the Act, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform you that all the relevant documents submitted by your college in Part-1 proforma were examined by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board and it has been decided to issue Conditional permission to in Bhagwan Buddha Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital No. 103/6, 80 Feet BDA Road, V NGEF, Layout, Mallathalli, Bangalore, Karnataka-560056 for continuing admissions in 1- BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats for the academic year 2021-22.

2. On careful consideration of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has arrived at the following conclusion :-

That the applicant has set up the Homoeopathic Medical College and teaching Hospital with the component of staff, infrastructure, equipment and instruments and other facilities where as the College has to take urgent and time bound steps to implement Minimum Standard Requirements of the Homoeopathy College and attached Hospital as prescribed by the National Commission for Homoeopathy for conducting undergraduate and Post graduate courses in Homoeopathy. The deficiencies are as follows:



**A. Discrepancies in engagement of Teaching staff:**

- i. Experience certificate of Dr. Srinivas Guest Professor in department of pathology has not been submitted.
- ii. The college is not having required Guest Faculty as per MSR, 2013.
- iii. Dr. Ramesh, Professor Forensic Medicine and Toxicology is not having required experience of 4 years as lecturer.
- iv. Dr. Vishwanath K, Reader Pathology is not having required experience of 4 years as lecturer, Pathology.
- v. The College is not having required number of Teachers/Consultant of modern medicine.

As a part of assessment of the College, Hospital and its infrastructural & functional aspects, MARBH has conducted an online hearing on 07.10.21 and shortfalls observed in the College has been discussed in detail. The College is directed to fulfil all deficiencies within a period of 30 days as per the undertaking submitted in this regard. Keeping in view of the undertaking provided by the College, and after considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013, **Permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board is issued to Bhagwan Buddha Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital No. 103/6, 80 Feet BDA Road, V NGEF, Layout, Mallathalli, Bangalore, Karnataka-560056 for continuing admissions in 1-BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats for the academic year 2021- 22.**

4. All admissions in Under Graduate course shall be through NEET only. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted thereunder.

5. The category wise list of selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board as per rules.

6. The college has to comply with the full requirements of Minimum Standard Requirement Regulations, 2013 for conducting the course. All deficiencies observed and mentioned above which affects the performance of the academic Institution, through which College fails to fulfill the statutory requirements, has to be rectified within 30 days time from issue of this permission letter. Compliance report shall be submitted by the college to Medical Assessment and Rating Board accordingly. Subsequently, the Board shall verify the compliance well in time and may conduct Online/Physical inspection for verification of compliance as per the HCC (MSR) Regulation, 2013 and will consider admissions for the academic year 2022-23.
