Sub:- Admissions for the academic year 2018-19 in existing BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats at Bhagwan Buddha Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, 103/6, 40 feet BDA Road, NGEF Layout, Near Vinayaka Temple, Mallathalli, Bangalore - 560056 Reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the provisions prescribed under sub regulation 3(4) of HCC (MSR), 2013, wherein, the existing college has to fulfill the minimum standard requirement of infrastructure, teaching & training facilities by 31.12.2014 for consideration of grant of permission for undertaking admission in the coming academic year. As per the provision of sub regulation 3(9) of HCC (MSR), 2013, if the existing colleges fail to achieve full compliance of the requirements as specified in the regulation by 31.12.2014 the college may be stopped for taking admission in existing Courses. Further, as per the provision of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council (Amendment) Ordinance, 2018, all Homoeopathy Medical Colleges shall seek permission of the Central Government within 01 year from the said commencement in accordance with the provisions specified in the regulations made by the Central Council.

2. In order to verify the compliance of the College, the Board of Governors to CCH has conducted inspection of Bhagwan Buddha Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, 103/6, 40 feet BDA Road, NGEF Layout, Near Vinayaka Temple, Mallathalli, Bangalore - 560056, Karnataka, on 26.07.2018 and furnished the recommendation as under:

"Recommended for allowing admission in I-BHMS for the session 2018-19 with the intake capacity allowed earlier subject to the removal of deficiencies reflected in the report of inspection before 31.12.2018"

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3. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council (Amendment) Ordinance, 2018, HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, recommendations of the Board of Governors to CCH and Policy of the Central Government for granting conditional permission during the session 2018-19, **permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to Bhagwan Buddha Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, 103/6, 40 feet BDA Road, NGEF Layout, Near Vinayaka Temple, Mallathalli, Bangalore - 560056 , Karnataka for continuing admissions in 1- BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats and subject to condition that the college shall fulfill the following requirements by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2018:**


- i. All the Minimum Standard Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standards Requirement of Homoeopathic Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations 2013" by 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018 to get permission for a period not exceeding five years. Failing which, all the existing colleges, which are not able to achieve full compliance of the requirement as specified in these regulations by the 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2018, shall be denied permission from academic year 2019-20 onwards and action as envisaged under section 19 of the Act shall be initiated against all such colleges apart from rejection of their applications under sections 12A, which have been under consideration by way of conditional permissions or denials"; and
- ii. All the requirements under the provisions of the HCC Act, 1973 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.

4. The College has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2018 for continuing admissions during the subsequent years. A copy of the compliance report shall be submitted by the college to CCH under intimation to this Ministry. Subsequently, CCH shall verify the compliance well in time for considering the admissions during the Academic Year 2019-20 and furnish the recommendation to the Central Government.


